reduce fine lines around the eyes and mouth

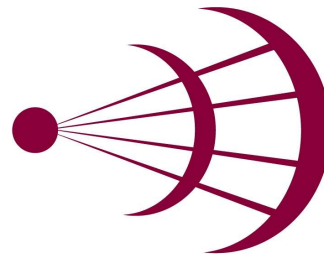
Treat wrinkles caused by sun damage, aging and family history.

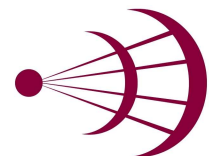

What is a Chemical Peel?

A topical non-invasive treatment technique used to improve and smooth the texture of the skin using a chemical solution that causes the dead skin to slough or peel off. The regenerated skin is usually smoother and less wrinkled than the old skin. The regenerated skin is also temporarily more sensitive to the sun.



How long will it take?

- All Chemical peels are done after a Chemical peel consult. This is to ensure that the correct peel is chosen for each skin type and skin condition.
- At Creekside Aesthetics we offer an express peel that could be done over your lunch hour.
- Most peels only take about 45 minutes to an hour.

What will my skin look like after a Chemical Peel?

Directly after the peel your skin will look dewy, and maybe a little bit red.

We do offer a free make up application so there is no problem going back to work or about your day.

Skin will start to actively peel 2 to 3 days after the treatment and continue to do so for anywhere between 1 to 3 days.
